

## LL.B. (Three Year) Professional Degree Course

The student shall be required to study 23 compulsory theory papers and 4 compulsory practical papers in addition to 3 optional papers (30 papers in all) over a period of three years during 6 semesters according to the scheme given below:

### Sixth Semester

#### **Compulsory:**

1. Principles of Taxation Law
2. Social Security and Social Welfare Laws
3. Interpretation of Statutes

#### **Optional:**

4. Media and Law

Or,

Human Rights: Law and Practice

#### **Practical:**

5. Moot Court, Pre-Trial and Internship [*Moots: 30 Marks; Pre-trial and Internship: 60 Marks; Viva: 10 Marks*]

Fifth Internship: For 10 days after the completion of class-teaching of the theory course. *This will include the "Pre-trial and Internship" component of the above Practical Paper of the Sixth Semester.* In this duration, every student shall be required:- (i) to attend Lawyers' chambers and District-level Courts for 9 days at Almora; and (ii) to visit the High Court of Uttaranchal at Nainital *at least* for 1(One) day.
